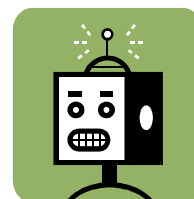




ALPHABET SOUP

Practice spelling the music alphabet in
every other letter order.

Spell alphabet soup from *each* letter of the music
alphabet.



BEAT RADAR

Memorize the tempo of 60 beats per minute.

Practice tapping 60 bpm for a full minute,
without speeding up or slowing down!

RHYTHM KING CARD

When listening to music during the day,
try to identify the *meter* of the music you hear.

Practice *tapping eighth notes* on your leg
to the pulse of the music you hear.



Music Science Lab

Compose 4 measures of melody in any key.

Write out the melody in treble clef.
Write chords in the bass clef.

SINGING NINJA CARD



Sing the major scale starting from any pitch.

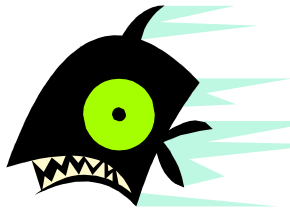
Sing in numbers. Sing in Letters. Sing Solfege.



SPEED READER

Flip through your flashcards
as fast as you can.

Time yourself to see how fast you can go.



SPEED DEMON

Play major scales with your metronome at *forte*.

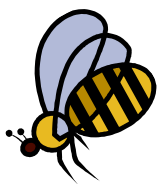
Try to play the scale faster each day.

Snapshot Pass

Look at 4 measures of music you've never seen
before. Study it for one minute.

Close the score and go to the piano.
Play as much as you can remember.



SPELLING BEE

Practice spelling a major key each day
alphabetically, forwards and backwards.

Name each degree of the scale
using your degree cards.



STAR PERFORMER

Memorize eight bars of music to *perfection*.

Include all the dynamics, articulations
and tempos that you like.



THEORY DETECTIVE

Choose 8 bars of music to study
away from the piano.

Describe everything you see in the music
in musical terms like, scales, chords, arpeggios, etc.



COPY CATS

Listen carefully to 2 measures of melody, as many
times as you need to remember the sound.

Try to play the melody on the piano "by ear".
